Nº 235 /**CONSIDERING:** Provisions in Law Nº 18.755

**Article 3.-** - The owners or holders of swine shall keep the animals confined, in enclosures, keeping hedges, boundaries and doors in such conditions as will prevent animals from walking out.

The SAG can apply the measures in article Nº 9 in DFL. RRA. Nº 16, of 1963, to such pigs as will be found in public roads, dumping grounds, riverbanks, or any other place which shall not comply with the requirements in the above paragraph.

**Article 6.-** It is hereby forbidden to feed pigs with animal origin wastes from abattoirs, restaurants, hospitals, cafeterias or canteens, or any other establishment whatsoever, except in those cases in which the corresponding SAG Regional Director, through a justified resolution will so expressly authorize. Anyhow, such wastes shall be subjected to a cooking process, which shall guaranty the destruction of the infectious agents.

It is likewise hereby prohibited to feed pigs with wastes from places for the final disposal of garbage.
