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Subject to the following conditions:

1. The animals must be accompanied by this original permit.
2. A veterinarian authorised thereto by the Veterinary Authority of Botswana must certify the health requirements on the certificate overleaf or on a health certificate conforming thereto. In the latter case reference must be made to the Namibian import permit number;
3. The State Veterinarian, Gobabis, Telephone: +264-61-56 2441 must be timeously advised of the probable date and time of arrival of the animal/s from Botswana. Arrival of the animal/s at the final destination in Namibia must be reported to the State Veterinarian, Gobabis, immediately. Seals of the truck/s may not be broken or the animals off-loaded without his authorisation.
4. All animals must be clinically healthy and free from infectious diseases and visibly free from external parasites.
5. The animals must be individually marked by easily identifiable means.
6. Only mechanical transport will be allowed.
7. This permit is valid until and for one movement only.

VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE

I, a veterinarian authorised thereto by the Veterinary Administration of Botswana hereby certify the following:

- 1. The animals described here under:
 - 1.1. originate from a herd situated in the O.I.E. recognised Foot and Mouth Disease-free zone in Botswana and a farm not under veterinary restrictions for diseases to which the species are susceptible;
 - 1.2. were kept in O.I.E. recognised Foot and Mouth Disease-free zone in Botswana the since birth;
 - 1.3. are individually marked by easily identifiable means;
 - 1.4. were treated for sheep scab with an approved remedy within 4 days prior to export.
- 2. Prior to movement to Namibia the animals were isolated at the establishment for three weeks. After two weeks they were subjected to the complement fixation test for brucellosis with negative results. Should any of the animals test positive, positive animals should be removed and the whole group re-tested after three weeks.
- 3. The animals were inspected by me on the day of embarkation and found to be clinically healthy and free from infectious diseases and infection with external parasites and fit to travel.
- 4. The animals were loaded onto clean vehicles /containers which are suitable for the transport of the species concerned and was sealed under official supervision.
