PERMIT FOR THE IMPORT OF LIVE CLOVEN-HOOFED GAME ANIMALS FROM SOUTH AFRICA INTO NAMIBIA (Excl Buffalo and Wildebeeste)

(Issued in terms of the Animal Diseases and Parasite act, no.13 of 1956, as amended)

subject to the following conditions:

1. That the animals originate from either the Western Cape or Northern Cape provinces and were resident there for a period of at least six months.
2. The animals' first destination in Namibia shall be(farm name and number) in the district and may not be removed therefrom without authorisation of the state veterinarian.
3. The animals shall be accompanied by this import permit and all necessary documentation required as set out in the health certificate attached hereto, issued by an Official Veterinarian authorised thereto by national Directorate of Veterinary Services.
4. The arrival of the consignment must be timeously reported to the State Veterinarian Telephone and the seals may not be broken or the animals released without his/her permission. Supervision of off-loading will be at importer's cost.
- 5.. The animals shall be transported in **sealed trucks** and the seal numbers must be endorsed on the Veterinary Health Certificate.

This permit is valid until and for one movement only.

PLEASE NOTE - Imports are subject to compliance with Nature Conservation legislation. Failure to comply with any of the conditions may result in refusal of entry into Namibia and/or prosecution.

VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE

I, a veterinarian authorized thereto by the Veterinary Authority of South Africa hereby certify that:

- 1. The animals originate from Western Cape or Northern Cape provinces only and from an area which is not under restriction for any disease to which the species are susceptible. The animals were kept at the premises of origin since birth or at least for the past six months. During this period the animals to be exported did not come into contact with any animals of lower health status;
- 2. The animals were inspected within 72 hours prior to movement to Namibia during which time they were found clinically healthy and free from infectious diseases.
