1. **The importer accepts the sole responsibility of ensuring that the conditions below have been complied with, and understands his/her duty in this regard.**
2. The consignment must be accompanied by this **ORIGINAL** permit and with the veterinary certificate (overleaf) duly completed and signed by a veterinarian authorised thereto by the Government of the Republic of South Africa.
3. The product must be handled hygienically at all times and transported so that spoilage does not occur.
4. The **IMPORTER** must inform the State Veterinarian,Telephone:
 Fax..... of the estimated date of arrival of the consignment and arrival of the consignment at destination must be reported to the State Veterinarian immediately. **The seals may not be broken or the goods off-loaded without his/ her permission.**
5. **The State veterinarian at destination** must be informed **by fax** of the dispatch of the consignment.
6. This permit is valid for one consignment only.

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Note: 1. This authorization does not absolve the importer from obtaining permission for the importation of this product, which might be required by other Namibian legislation.

2. In case of transit through Botswana, it is the responsibility of the importer to obtain permission from the Veterinary Authorities of Botswana for the transit movement.

B: VETERINARY HEALTH CERTIFICATE

I,a **veterinarian** authorised thereto by the Veterinary Authority of the Republic of South Africa hereby certify in respect of the meat product(s) described in **Section A** that:

- 1. The meat derived from(animal species)
- 2. The carcasses, meat or offal described are derived from cattle, sheep, goats or pigs which:
 - 2.1 are of South African origin
 - 2.2 originate from the OIE recognized Foot and mouth disease free zone of South Africa and from farms not under veterinary restriction for FMD control or any disease to which the species is susceptible.
 - 2.3 were not vaccinated against Foot-and-Mouth Disease.
 - 2.4 In the case of **PIGS** are from approved piggeries outside the ASF controlled areas or approved double fenced facilities in the case of farms in ASF control areas and herds which were serologically tested for Porcine reproductive and respiratory syndrome (PRRS) with negative results.
 - 2.5 were slaughtered at an abattoir approved for export to Namibia by the official South African veterinary authority.
- 3. The Republic of South Africa is historically free from Rinderpest, East Coast Fever, Vesicular Stomatitis, Scrapie, Swine Vesicular disease, Enterovirus encephalomyelitis of swine and Bovine Spongiform Encephalitis.
- 4. The products:
 - 4.1 were processed at a veterinary approved processing facility, monitored by the South African Veterinary authorities and where hygiene conditions are satisfactory in all respects.
 - 4.2 Are safe and unconditionally fit for human consumption.
- 5. The markings on the packaging containing the finished product are fully descriptive and identify the plant of origin.
- 6. The motor vehicle or container used for conveyance of the product conforms to internationally accepted standards of cleanliness, construction, maintenance and operation, was loaded under supervision and sealed immediately after loading at the approved facility.
