*If destined to north of and including Washington, DC (38° N) and east of and including Salt Lake City, UT (115° W), shipment is subject to inspection.

If destined to an area other than those listed above, fumigation treatment T104(a)(1) is required.

**Currently, only Puerto Rico has facilities for hot water treatment of mangoes.

***If okra is destined to the following states, fumigation treatment T104(a)(2) is required: Alabama, Arizona, Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, Missouri, Nevada, New Mexico, North Carolina, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, or Virginia.

For the States of Illinois, Kentucky, Missouri, and Virginia, only those shipments destined to areas of the State that are south of the 38th parallel required treatment.

If okra is destined to a State not listed above, the shipment must be for consumption or immediate processing, or fumigation treatment T104(a)(2) is required.

****If moving to a North Atlantic (NA) location, the movement is only allowed under a Hyattsville issued permit for fumigation at the port of arrival.
